- Clothing should be bagged – if on hangers, hangers can be hung along inside of trailer
- Donation receipts are stocked in trailer
- Trailer is delivered and lock is opened – key will be inside trailer. When event is complete, leave key in trailer and lock the padlock.
- Our driver will be by to pick-up on Monday or Tuesday after the event.

- Clothing, including torn, worn, etc...
- Linens
- Small household appliances
- Kitchenware, lamps, knick knacks
- Office supplies, computers, keyboards, printers – (computer items do not need to be in working condition)
- Shoes, boots, slippers, etc...
- Furniture – we ask that you please donate with dignity – if it is torn, broken, stained, we cannot accept.
- Purses, suitcases, books, albums, DVDs, CDs,
- Backpacks, extra school supplies

- Mattresses
- Pianos
- Organs

- Sofa Sleepers
